#### Session 5: Ordering, comparing and rounding decimal numbers

#### *Explore & deepen your learning*

Here are some investigations, games and activities for you to try at home to stretch you more after each session:

#### Largest Wins Game

Using this board and two sets of cards 1-9 (you could use playing cards or make your own) the aim of the game is to make the largest 5 digit number.

Shuffle the two sets of cards together. Take it in turn to turn over a card and decided which place value column you will place it in. Once you have placed the card you cannot move it. Continue until both of your grids are full. The winner is the player with the largest number.

To vary the game, you could try to make a number closest to a 5 digit target (for example 45,000) or aim to make the smallest number.
